* Cross Mud Cut Rd. onto Rock House Rd.

* Providence Farm is the 2nd drive on the right.

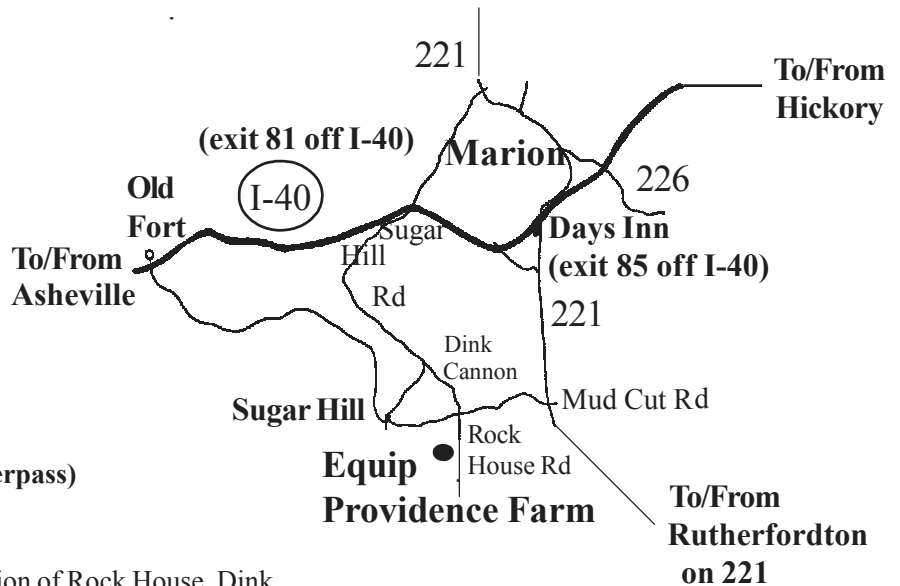
* From the south - Rutherfordton (Rte. 64 overpass)

* Providence Farm is the 2nd drive on the right.



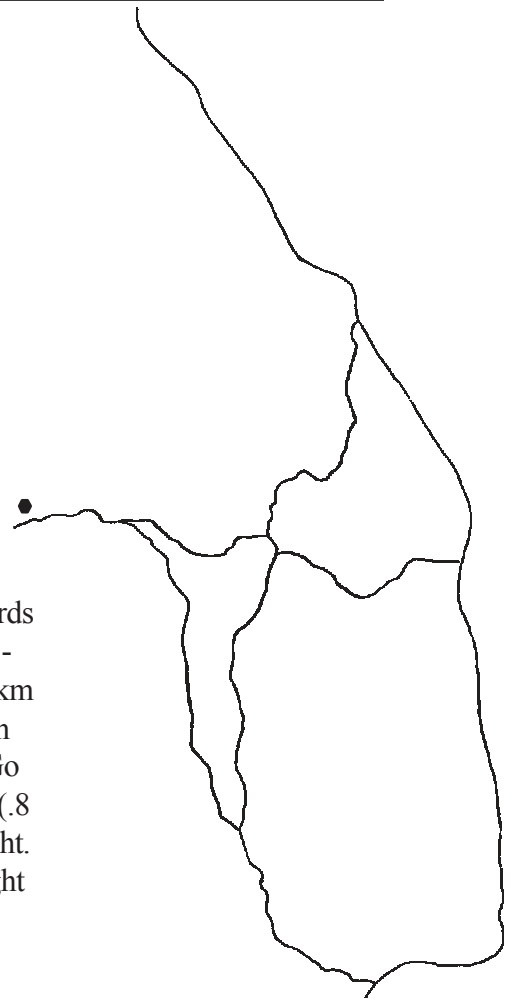
Canada Program Location

When leaving Victoria, travel north on the Trans-Canadian Highway towards Nanaimo. At the second traffic light in Mill Bay at the Shawnigan Lake - Mill Bay Road, turn left towards Shawnigan Lake. After going about 6.5 km (4 miles) to the stop sign in Shawnigan Lake. Turn right on to Shawnigan Lake Road. After about .7 km (.4 mile) bear left onto Renfrew Road. Go 6.8 km (4.25 miles) until the pavement ends. After another 1.25 km (.8 mile) on the gravel road, the driveway for The Knoll will be on the right. Look for the red reflective triangle hanging under The Knoll sign on the right hand side of the road.

Housing will be provided at Equip International in Marion, NC.

Meals will be provided for Food Production, Foundation for Farming, Well Drilling, Filter Tech, Pumping Water Technologies, and Aquaponics.
