- ❖ You dance with huge spiders and scorpions while trying to remove them from your presence.
- ❖ You hear cars honking day and night so their gates will be opened to get into their compounds.
- ❖ In December through at least February, you can take a shower with the cold tap water and it comes out warm...no need for a water heater.

A Malawian friend of mine from the 1st place I lived (their gardener – "G") has been having extreme spiritual warfare and he is a growing believer. His wife moved back to her way distant village and took his kids. Recently the youngest boy of about 5 years of age was taken to start learning how to be a w--- doctor. She was using the w-dr to try to heal their kids too. Of course, you can imagine how disturbing that would be to have this happen to your children. After months of deliberations between the families (Uncles are the ones that involve themselves in family matters.) and lots of prayer, the wife agreed to burn all the w-dr stuff and go to the pastor of their church for prayer instead. They no longer send their child to the Uncle w-dr and things are going much better. Please pray for this family!
