Throughout our years of working here, we have learned just how appropriate this verse is for Equip. As it has so often been said in the past, it's always good to hear from former students who are applying what they've learned at Equip. We've found time and time again that training and teacher/student – interaction doesn't stop with the completion of a course here. Often Kieth has been called upon by telephone, letter, or emails for advice, contacts, and other information to help missionaries or individuals on the field.

For example, Kieth has recently had extensive communications with a former well drilling student who has been ministering in Haiti. He was trying to finish a well that someone else had started and wanted to begin another well also. There were many technical problems and questions that needed Kieth's input and assistance. Kieth was able to offer advice and to put him in contact with others who could help him complete these well drilling projects. The first well is now providing water for an orphanage.

Another former student who has been communicating with Kieth was working in Kenya and has helped establish someone there in the production of the new round BioSand Water Filter. He was able to help produce six concrete filter bodies before he had to return to the States. Interesting note: the success of the filter was verified when filtered water was offered alongside unfiltered water to some guard dogs at a facility. The dogs would not touch the unfiltered water! It's always great to realize success in ministry!

In this modern age of advanced technology – the computer is truly a marvelous instrument and one which Kieth utilizes often. It's almost as if he is there on the field. He is able to have instant access back and forth, thus sharing in the problems and progress of the one with whom he is communicating. We are also able to pray together for other needs and situations that often arise in the life of a missionary. There is much rejoicing together over answered

prayers and each success achieved when a ministry project has been completed.

All throughout the process of a project like well drilling or constructing water filters, relationships are established and built with those with whom you are working. But, many times (correction: every time) in well drilling projects particularly, it is necessary to be prepared for the unexpected. Lost or broken components, difficulty in obtaining parts, terrain challenges, and other extra unanticipated costs, complications, and delays present challenges which are actually opportunities for God to prove Himself faithful and more than able to accomplish His purposes in the lives of His children. It is times like these that causes our faith to grow and expand and our wonder at an almighty God to be enlarged. As you work alongside the people you are seeking to help, it is a wonderful blessing to see the difference being made in their lives not only physically, but most importantly, spiritually as well. We are glad to have even a small part in this cycle of ministry.
